MacArthur Research Network on Adolescent Development and Juvenile Justice. She is a member of San Francisco Mayor London Breed's Blue Ribbon Task Force to reform the San Francisco juvenile justice system and she is the Chairperson for the San Francisco Board of Supervisors Working Committee to Close Juvenile hall.
