Sable Horton is the owner of Agape Design Expressions, a small business specializing in using creativity to create products and experiences for the community that are limitless, timeless, and unconditional. The business customizes apparel and miscellaneous items and hosts various art and healing workshops throughout the year. A portion of all proceeds goes towards defeating human trafficking and pouring into the next generation. She hires survivors of sex trafficking and helps them find their voice as they help others heal through art and creativity.

As a Modern-Day Abolitionist, Sable works and consults for several anti-human trafficking organizations to help them better serve survivors of human trafficking. She has years of experience in delivering trainings and is well known for speaking on public panels, helping with workshops, and participating in awareness campaigns to help spread awareness about human trafficking. As a survivor of sex trafficking and as someone who has been working in the anti-trafficking world for several years, she has a unique perspective on the challenges human trafficking survivors face and the ways community organizations can effectively serve them.

Sable is a 2020 recipient of the Bay Area Inspire Awards, an award given to young innovators who are committed to social change. Through this project, Sable has been able to develop a prevention education curriculum and teach it to young people over Zoom, helping them to stay safe during the pandemic. In January of 2021, Sable will be launching her non-profit organization, Shades of Beauty, to further help youth in the community and those at risk of exploitation.
