Toni serves as the Executive Director of San Francisco SafeHouse, where she works to further the SafeHouse mission to empower and support women who are experiencing housing instability and sexual exploitation or trafficking by creating survivor-centered spaces, services, advocacy, and community education.

As a survivor herself, she has a deep commitment to ensuring that survivors' voices are being heard and those seeking services are receiving trauma informed care and obtaining the support needed to heal. In addition, she is a graduate of San Francisco SafeHouse and uses her personal experience as motivation and inspiration to continue serving survivors of sexual exploitation.

For the past three years, she has expanded SafeHouse programs to include a drop-in center with case management, rapid rehousing, and emergency hotel voucher programs. Additionally, she founded the Women's Housing Coalition and advocates for the expansion of services for women experiencing trafficking and homelessness.

Toni holds a Master's in Social Work and Bachelor's in Women and Gender Studies from San Francisco State University.
